With so many vendors interested in this event, starting this year, vendor space will be juried. Potential vendors are invited to apply by February 1, 2024, for priority consideration. Payment will not be submitted until you are confirmed as a vendor.

Vendor set up time: Vendors have the option to set up Friday, April 19, from 3pm to 6:45pm EST and/or on Saturday, April 20, from 8am to 10am EST. While campus buildings will be locked at 7pm on Friday, April 19, many vendor spaces will be in open hallways.

Event Location: BAY-CON takes place on the Escanaba campus of Bay College. Much of the vending for the event will occur in and around Conference Room 952 in the Joseph Heirman Building (900). The [JHUC is located on the south side of campus](#), and free parking is in Lot A on the south side of campus off of Danforth Rd.

Vendor spaces/fee: There are several different options for vending space. All spaces are limited.

Option 1 in large vendor room: \$75 for a 10'x10' space in room 952 (max 2 spaces per vendor). 8'x29.5" as well as 5'x2' tables are available at no cost. Note that two 8'x29.5" tables will not fit in an "L" shape in a 10'x10' space.

Option 2 in hallways: \$30 for one table, \$20 each additional table (up to a total of three tables), 8'x29.5" tables are provided at no cost. Tables in hallways cannot be moved.

Option 3 in classrooms: \$30 for one 6' table, \$10 for additional tables, up to a total of four tables. Tables are 6' long and range from 24" to 29.5" wide.

Payment: Payment will be completed after a vendor is selected. The College accepts cash, credit/debit card, or check/money order made out to "Bay College". Payment information will be provided to selected vendors.
